Applying for Funding

All children are eligible for 15 hours, starting the term after they turn three. You don't need a code to claim. Eligible Families will receive up to 1140 hours per year, or 30 hours per week, term-time only. To find out if you qualify, apply for a Working Families Code via Best Start In Life.

You can go ahead and reserve your place with us before you get your eligibility code. It is best to reserve your spot as early as possible.

Voluntary enrichment fee

When comparing our fees, please consider the additional meal and consumables charges at other nurseries. The fees listed on our website are all inclusive. We do not add additional fees to those listed.

The voluntary enrichment fee is already included in the fees listed on our website. The fee for using your full 30-hour entitlement across the year is £33 per week. The fee for using your full 15-hour entitlement across the year is £16.50 per week. If you use part of your full entitlement or attend term-time only, the enrichment fee is charged at £1.50 per hour.

While the Early Years Free Entitlement provides essential support, it does not fully cover the actual costs of the high-quality services we offer at our nursery. We pride ourselves on delivering an exceptional experience for every child, supported by our highly qualified team of educators dedicated to fostering a nurturing learning environment. Our comprehensive curriculum includes engaging classes and activities that support holistic development, along with healthy meal options that promote well-being. We also enrich our program with unique experiences, such as vegetable planting and exploration of our extensive outdoor environment, providing children with valuable opportunities for outdoor play and learning.
